Be Involved in God's Work This Summer!

When children are baptized or dedicated at our church, the whole congregation makes a promise to participate in Jesus' Great Commission in their lives: "teaching them to obey everything that I (Jesus) have commanded you" (Mt 28:20) as they grow up. Throughout this summer we have a variety of exciting ways adults can live into these baptismal vows for children and youth in our church family, as well as share God's love and truth with kids and families in the College Hill community who do not yet know Jesus.

We invite and challenge each member of our congregation to live into the commitment they've made to raise our children in the way of Jesus by partnering with us in Children, Youth & Family Ministries this summer. Here are some ways you can get involved:

1. Intentional Prayer

- Pray that God will work in powerful ways in the lives of kids, youth and families throughout the summer. Pray that kids
 and youth will take a step forward in faith and come to know and follow Jesus more closely. Pray that adult and youth
 leaders will be empowered by the Holy Spirit to share Jesus boldly. Pray that the Holy Spirit will work in the hearts of
 the kids and families who do not yet know Jesus to bring them to trust and follow Jesus as their Lord and Savior this
 summer!
- An intentional prayer team will be formed this year that will be emailed updates with specific prayer requests throughout the summer: Fill out the insert in your bulletin to join.

2. Come to Resident Camp, July 2-8!

- Camp Counselor: You'll be assigned to care for and build relationships with 8-10 kids (finishing 2nd-6th grade) along with at least one other co-counselor. This is a week-long commitment (July 2-8) where you will stay in a cabin with your campers. We offer a stipend of \$350, but also welcome counselors who volunteer their time.
- Work Crew Leader: Come build relationships with Jr. High students (finishing 7th-9th grade)! The Work Crew does a project for the camp and supports activities for younger campers, but also participates in their own small group Bible study times and adventure activities. This is a week-long commitment (July 2-8) where you will stay in a cabin with the Work Crew. We offer a stipend of \$350, but also welcome leaders who volunteer their time.



- Camp Support Staff: Additional adults are needed at camp to spend time with campers who need one-on-one attention, help with activity set-up and clean-up, and to be available to provide transportation for campers who are sent home early due to behavior issues. Your commitment could be for just one day, a few days, or the entire week. If you stay the night, there are hotel-style rooms with private bathrooms in the camp lodge, so you can still help in this way even if you aren't the "camping" type!
- Transportation: Many families who would like to send their children to camp do not have a car to drive them there. We need adults from our congregation to commit to driving a family to camp on Monday, July 3rd and home from camp on Saturday, July 8th. Camp Cotubic is about two hours away from CHPC, and both drives will be in the early afternoon. This is a great way to get connected with a new family who may not have a church home!



3. Mentor an Intern

We're looking for mature believers who would like to pour into high school and college age students who are working as Children, Youth and Family Interns. You'd meet with this student every other week this summer (end of May - beginning of August) to pray with, encourage, and challenge them.

4. Teach Swim Ministry

- Expect to be part of a miracle! For youth (at least 11 yrs old) and adults. Must (1) be growing as a Christian, (2) love children, (3) have a sense of humor, (4) enjoy the water, (5) be teachable. Youths must swim at the American Red Cross Level 4 or above. Adults, a willingness to mentor teens is key; experience as a Life Guard/ Water Safety Instructor is helpful but not required.
- Swim Ministry Training: June 15-17, Teaching Week #1: June 26-30, Week #2: July 17-21, Week #3: July 31-August 4



5. Scholarships

 We don't want cost to keep any child/youth from being part of our exciting summer plans! Please prayerfully consider if you are able to bless a family by providing a scholarship for their child.
