REVEAL 2 Survey: Are We Growing in the Spirit?

If you sat down with Jesus for a chat and He asked you "how is your spirit growing" what would you say? What would your answer reveal about you? How have you matured spiritually since beginning your walk with the Lord? What helped you grow? What will help you continue to grow? How do we grow as a congregation and how do we know that we are growing? These and other questions are the focus of what CHPC and others are calling Spiritual Formation.

Almost two years ago CHPC began this new emphasis on Spiritual Formation with a survey designed to measure our spiritual health as a congregation. It is now time for a spiritual checkup in which we inventory our congregational health again through a survey we are calling REVEAL 2.

Although each member will be invited to participate in the REVEAL 2 survey, only the church as a whole will receive a score, individuals will not receive a personal score. This way we can compare congregational growth during the past two years. Picture yourself sitting down with Jesus and answering His question, "how is your spirit growing." The inventory is computer based, will be on the web and takes about 35 (some say 45) minutes to complete. Members without computer access will be able to take the survey at the church. The first REVEAL inventory will open in less than two weeks on Saturday, March 3 and close Monday, March 19.
