The Search:

- In November, December and January we received and reviewed almost twenty resumes, conducted four preliminary phone interviews, and narrowed the field to three candidates with exceptional qualifications.
- In February, we will complete formal interviews.
- In March, we plan to extend an offer to our top candidate, so that our new Director will have some overlap with our current Director, Maggie Smith before she retires May 31, 2014.

Importance:

This position is vitally important to our church body as we help parents, surrounded by a culture increasingly opposed to a Biblical worldview, connect their children and families to Jesus and raise the next generation of leaders in our church, community and world.

- Please pray for the Search Committee as we seek God's guidance to find the person He has chosen to be our next Director of Children and Family Ministry. Pray that we would recognize the right person and that he/she would recognize us as the right place.
