Arts Revival of College Hill (ARCH) presents an award-winning dance/drama troupe from Payap University in Chiang Mai, Thailand. Chaing Mai is a cultural and educational center in the northern region of Thailand. In 2009, ARCH successfully presented The Thai Heritage Experience to a packed audience. The dancers and actors are professional staff members of the Christian Communications Institute (CCI) of the University.

During the school year, the troupe leads week-long renewal programs for elementary and secondary students. They teach values by using music, dance and drama. During the winter months the troupe performs traditional melodramas in rural villages on outdoor stages. Although the Institute's principal ministry is in Thailand, its performers have represented their country in more than a dozen countries on four continents.

Singer-Songwriter Dave Hawkins will MC and accompany 'Scenes of Thailand.' The troupe will present dazzling sights and sounds, dances from four regions of Thailand and a traditional Thai melodrama. Rev. Robert Collins and his wife, Dr. Esther Wakeman will narrate. Collins says, "Wherever we go, folks from the audience tell us, 'If we'd known how good this was, we would have promoted it much more.'"
