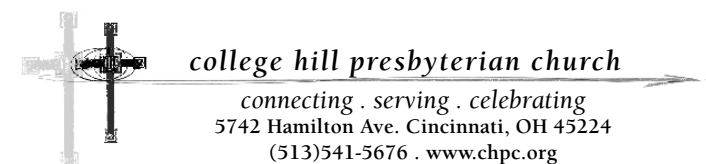
Available Help
