God Bless you all for your generosity! "Let the children come to me," said Jesus!

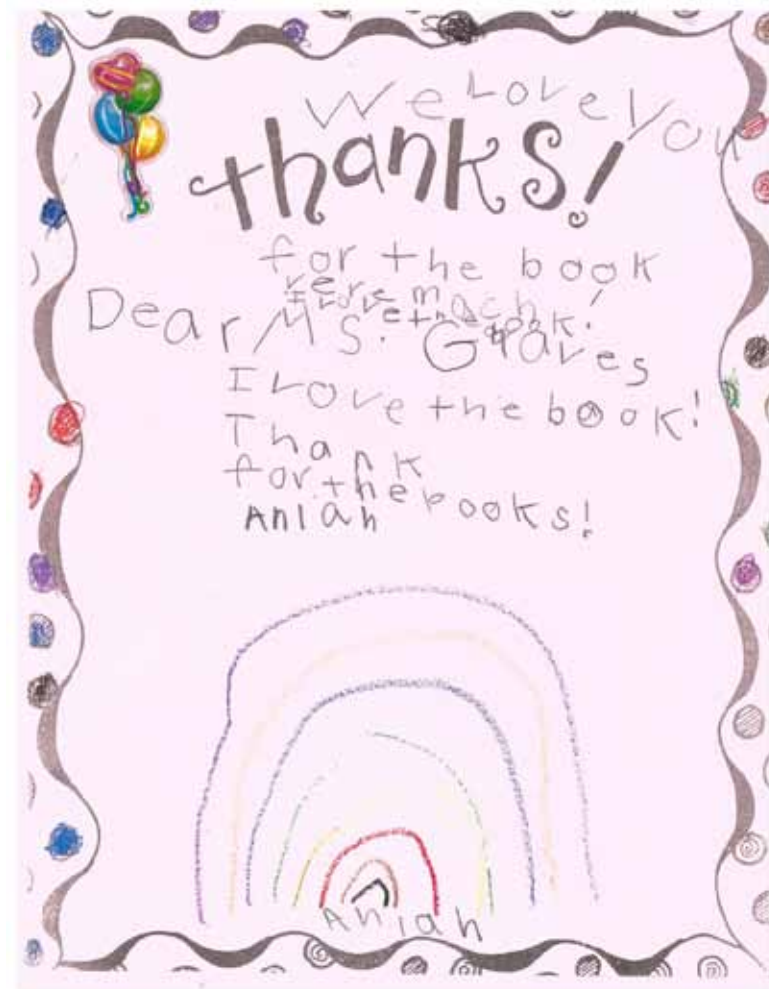
