Adult Spiritual Formation Update

Summer is almost here! During our summer term (June 1-July 27) we have an exciting lineup of classes planned. Even if you may be gone a few Sundays during the summer, make sure you sign up for one of the classes below and be transformed!

FA23: If: Gathering

This powerful series presents a fresh, deep, honest space for women to wrestle with the essential question: If God is real, then what? It challenges women in all generations to rise up and join together to love God. Come to this study to learn how to know God more deeply and to live out your purposes in this world. *Note: This class is for women only.* Led by Missi Kershner at 10:10am. Class size limited to 15.

FA20: Multiply

God wants disciples of Jesus to make other disciples of Jesus. Join Francis Chan, best-selling author and founding Pastor of Cornerstone Church, and David Platt, author and Pastor at The Church at Brook Hills, in this 5-part course - a simple, practical, biblical, helpful, and personal resource to help you understand Scripture and give you the tools to disciple others. This is a web-based course that includes a short video followed by a discussion period. Workbooks are free to download on line, but copies of each lesson will be distributed each week. While the course is laid out in 5 lessons, we will plan to use about 8-9 weeks to complete the study. Whether you're an old hand at sharing your faith or just beginning to explore how that fits into your life you'll discover new ways that discipleship can multiply the kingdom and your blessings. FA10: Connecting in Jesus No Matter Our Differences

We will be using a brand new resource, "The Multi-ethnic Christian Life Primer," which is the first personal devotional and small group study on multi-ethnic life and church designed for people in the pews. Through this eight-week experience you will grow in your understanding of the biblical mandate for the multi-ethnic church, and you'll gain practical insight for doing life together with diverse others beyond the distinctions of this world that so often and otherwise divide. Eight chapters (weeks) provide seven daily readings to stimulate personal and missional formation, focused on Theology, History, Considerations, Relationships, Communication, Competence, and Biblical Reflection. BT15: Ephesians

What are the astounding claims made in the book of Ephesians about God's plans for our lives from all eternity? How can we walk in a manner worthy of the amazing plans God has made for us? This verse-by-verse, expositional study will enable you to deepen your relationship with God as you learn to walk under His direction and in His love. Led by Scott Rice at 10:10am. Class size limited to 15.

SP10: Wake Up Your Heart

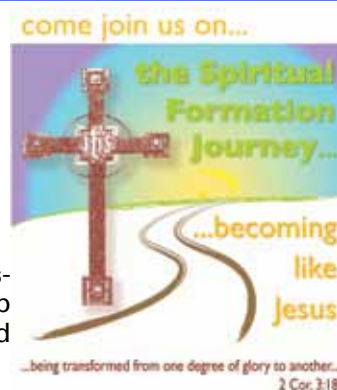
