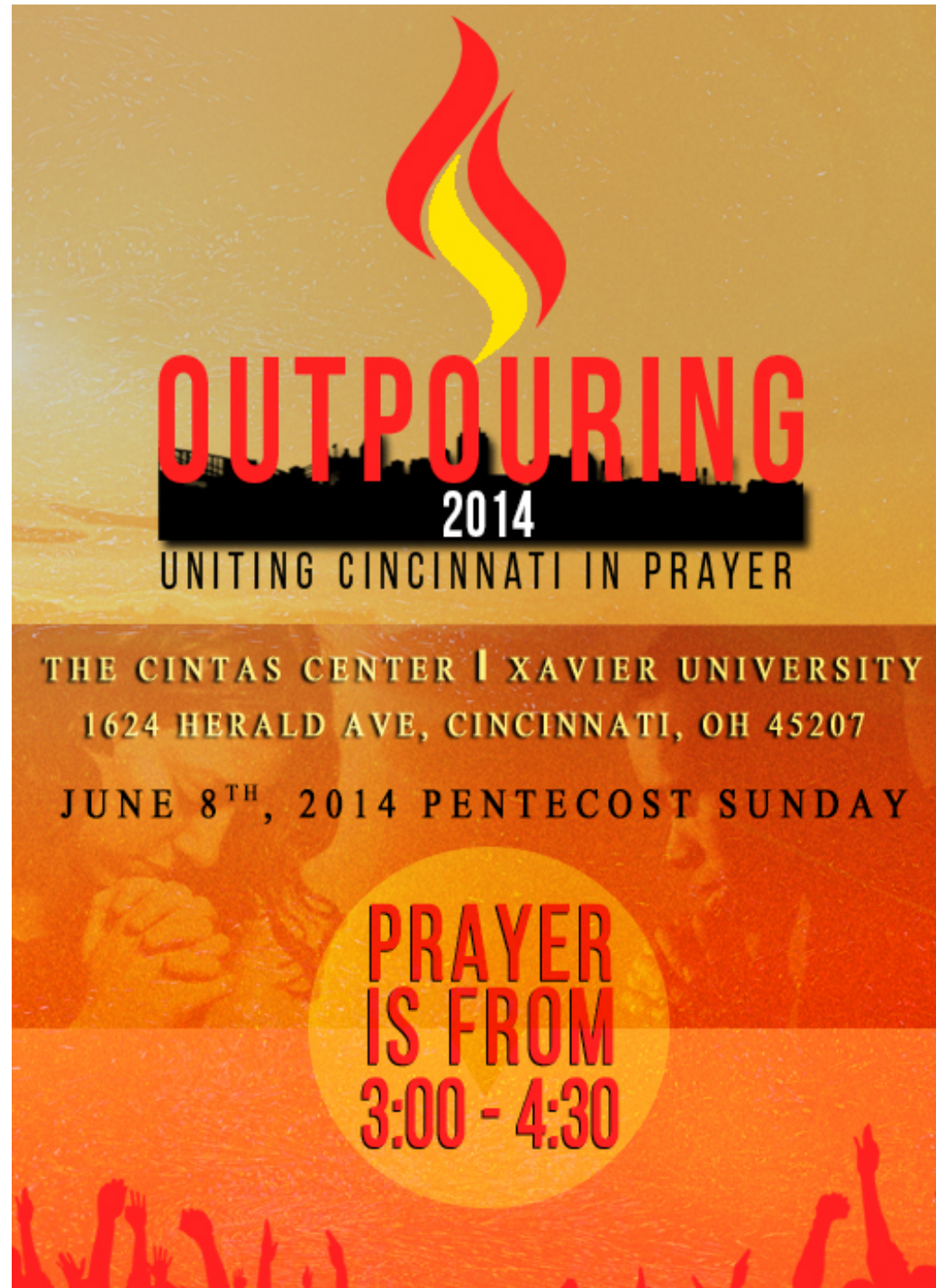


Hot Off the Press! 5/25/14
