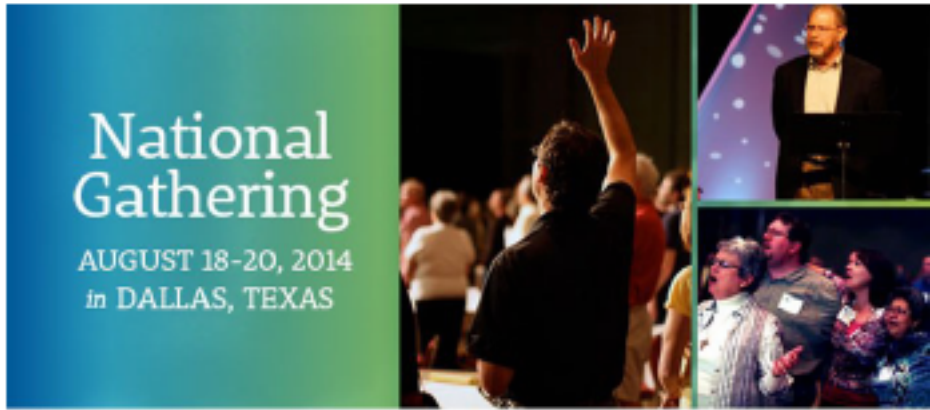

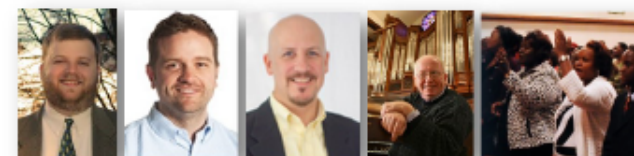
ECO Synod Meeting
