CHPC Covenant Partners and Friends:

In an effort to minimize disruption and inconvenience for CHPC and its operations, our paver, Neyra Paving Company, will (weather permitting) be doing the bulk of its remaining work on Monday, July 3 and Tuesday, July 4, when the church campus is closed. During the week of June 26, they'll be filling cracks in our main lot and doing final repairs. This will entail closing parts of our main lot on a rotating basis. On Monday, July 3, they'll close the entire main lot, and the White House Lot, including the 3Cs driveway, and clean it in preparation for sealcoating. That sealcoating will be performed on Tuesday July 4. On Wednesday July 5, the lot will remain closed for striping. It will be fully open and operational on Thursday, July 6.

Thus, ON WEDNESDAY July 5, please plan to arrive and depart from CHPC via ONLY the SALVIA AVENUE GATE. Please park ONLY ON THE NEW ASPHALT in the North Lot. By Wednesday, the sealcoat will be sufficiently set to walk across it (although we won't allow vehicle traffic on it that day). You may walk across the lot to the Atrium doors (be aware that the stripers will be working for part of Wednesday restoring the markings); however, if you wish to keep your shoes in their cleanest condition, you might want to use the Hamilton Ave. sidewalk to avoid walking on the newly sealed lot.

If the weather holds and nothing unforeseen interferes, we'll be re-opening the lots fully as of Thursday morning July 6 with our parking lot regeneration work completed.

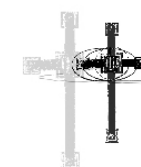
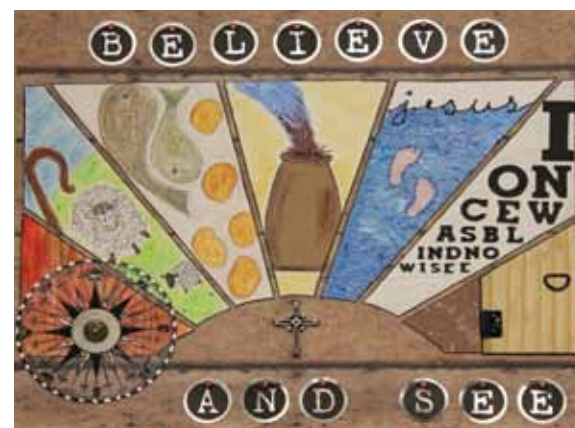
Available Help
