## Freedom

Around the celebration of Independence Day we pause and remember those who sacrificed for the freedom of this country. Maybe, right? Or we may be more focused on firing up the grill and eating hotdogs and hamburgers and preparing the award winning potato salad.

Do we do the same with our freedom in Christ? Do we stop and remember the sacrifice Jesus paid on the cross so we can experience the fullness of life? In Galatians 5:1, Paul reminds us "It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery." As Christians, there are times when our lives are more reflective of a prisoner than a free person. We get weighed down by the things of this world, by the deception of the Evil One and soon we believe the lies of the one who comes to do the opposite of Christ. We become entrapped by the one who comes to steal, kill and destroy. Suddenly, we are imprisoned once again by our thoughts, actions and sins.

Have you found yourself in that place? You find yourself feeling angry and bitter toward others, you numb yourself with alcohol, pornography, shopping, overeating or video games, you are hopeless and apathetic about life, you fill every moment of your day to avoid pain, relationships become self-serving, fear of failing causes paralysis and the list goes on. We all have those places of brokenness that cause pain and can quickly be the "yoke of slavery".

Here is the great news. 2 Corinthians 3:17 states "Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom." Jesus so desires for each of us to be released from prison. Surrender those places of brokenness to Him. Allow the Spirit to bring freedom in the way that only he can. Sometimes it helps to have someone walk the road toward freedom with you as you seek the Lord.

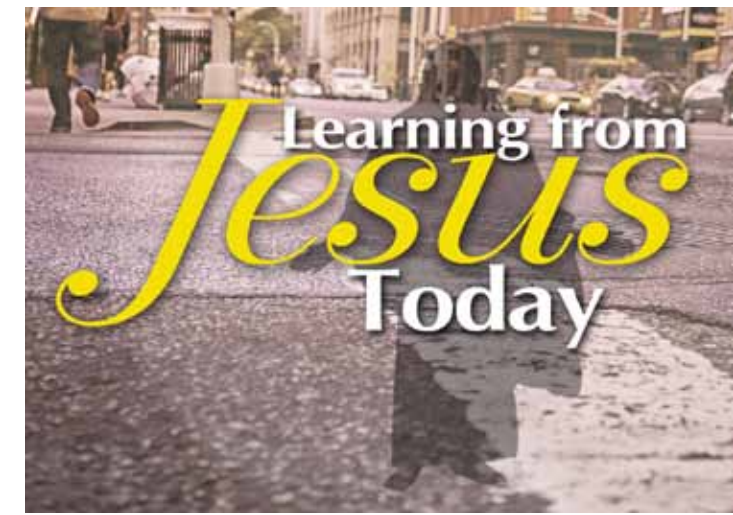

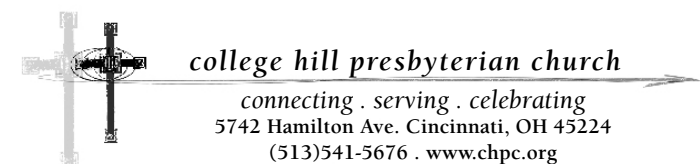
