Giving that doesn't cost you a cent!

Two of the ways we use are:

- (1) giving a % of all we spend at Kroger to Feast of Love Ministries; and
- (2) by providing airline tickets for others for mission-related travel.

The really good news is that neither of these cost us any additional money!

Here's how it works...

Contact Bev Graves, Director of Feast of Love, (513) 218-3316. She will provide the easy details for being a donor to Feast of Love through Kroger. [She might even register you.] You can get a Kroger Plus plastic card at any store's Service Desk. By 'registering' it each year, Kroger donates to Feast of Love. [The Feast of Love's Kroger Rewards ID number is #80601.]

When we buy groceries, Feast of Love gets a % of the total purchase... and it didn't cost us a cent more! In fact, we often save money.

Weekly Savings: Kroger has many products that they promote through discounts to customers 'with a Kroger Plus card.' Present the card at check out and watch the savings add up.

Food Savings: Once you have a Kroger's card, the Corporate Office, we also sign up for the special Customer program that sends Kroger coupons each month, i.e., \$5 off ____ (produce or meat or something major) and free mini-carrots. The coupons are usually for products that they know we buy by tracking our usage through our Kroger Plus cards.

Gasoline Savings: For every \$100 we spend at Kroger, we get an additional \$.10 a gallon off of our gas purchases. That's a deal at home and when traveling because Kroger has so many stores nation-wide. But the benefit doesn't stop there. [This sounds like a TV commercial.] We don't write a check or use cash to pay for our Kroger purchases. We use a credit card that gives us 2 Delta Airlines airmiles for every \$ spent. Our particular credit card also gives Delta airmiles, bonuses for spending a certain amount each year, and a free companion ticket for two people to fly for the price of one. We are able to give most of those airmiles to buy tickets for mission-related travel for others.

Over the years those air miles have sent people to Africa, Asia, Hungary, Australia, Tampa, Orlando and from Honduras (emergency eye care for a missionary). If you've ever had to buy an airline ticket on short notice or for international travel, you know how valuable those 'free tickets' are to missionaries. As the people have traveled, we have prayed for God to be glorified in their work. After their travel, we've celebrated with them what God had done.

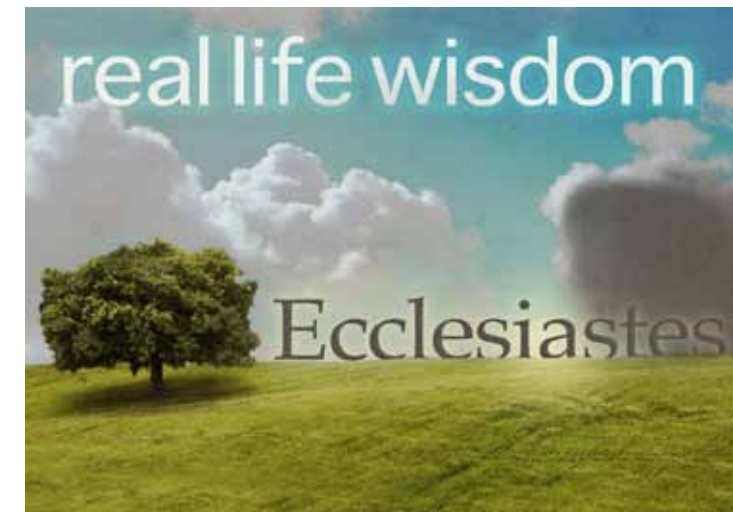
