

Hot Off the Press! 7/10/16



In about a month, students will be returning to school. For 13,000 of them, Tools for Schools will make the difference between having basic school supplies or not. This summer Tools for Schools is focusing on donations of Crayons + Cash.

For 16 years, God has used *Tools for School* as a practical means of expressing Christ's love and care for children and for building up city schools and teachers. TFS Crayons + Cash needs you...and others who you know (co-workers, neighbors, etc).

Envisioned by Feast of Love Ministries Co-Founder Karen Lane, *Tools for School* provides 'Tools for Success' to Cincinnati Public Schools where many families live below the 'poverty line.' Supplies are distributed through 30 Inner City Schools. During distribution, more that 60 volunteers assembled a total of 104,174 items for the schools.

Over the years, Tools for Schools has discovered that buying in bulk stretches donations and grant

money. \$20 provides the Basic Tools — pencils, pens, glue sticks, portfolios, scissors and spiral notebooks — for 2 and ½ students — example, TFS buys pencils for \$.06 that retail for \$.11. **\$11,000 in donations is needed now.**

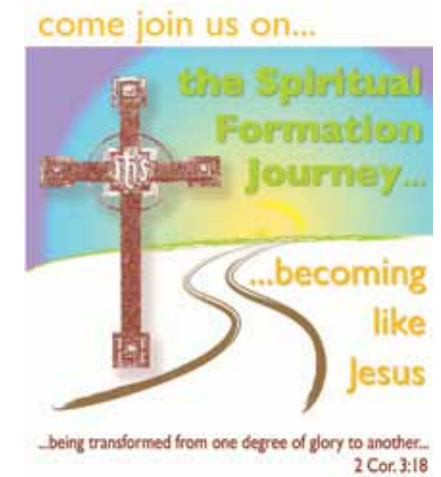

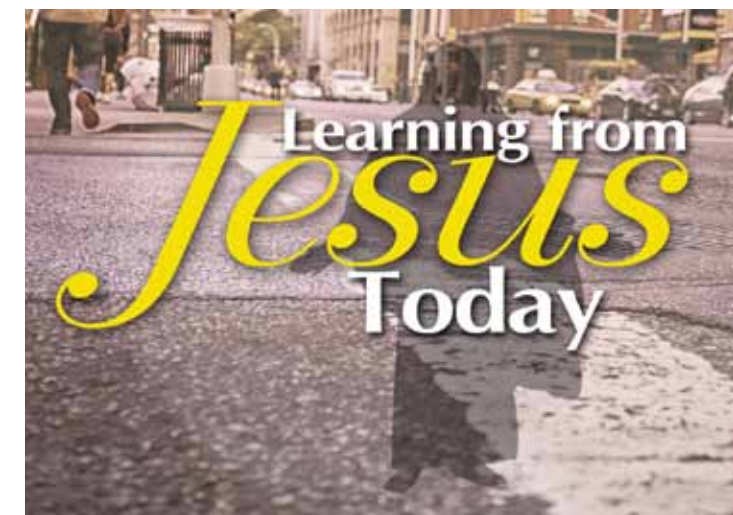
