Meet Pastor Dennis L. Hall...and Family

Dennis L. Hall has been on an amazing life journey that has led him with excitement and expectancy to be on staff and the next Assistant Pastor at College Hill Presbyterian Church.



Dennis most recently served as the Senior Associate Pastor of Adult Ministries at Concord Church an 8000+ member congregation where he oversaw all the Adult Ministries and served on the Executive Team. Prior to Concord, Dennis served as the Senior Pastor at Briar Creek Road Baptist Church, "THE CREEK", an urban multi ethnic congregation in Charlotte North Carolina for over 10 years. The highlights of Dennis' ministry at The Creek were developing leaders having led the charge to ordain 5 men and 5 women into the gospel ministry; the creation of a Community Center comprised of ESL classes, food pantry, clothing closet, Outreach Development Corporation 501c3, Child Development Center and Summer Camp; and the mentoring of 3 refugee congregations on the church campus: Montagnard, Burmese and Eritrean.

Dennis earned his Bachelor's degree with a double major in Rhetoric and Political Science from the University of Illinois, Champaign-Urbana, M.A.T.S. in New Testament from Gordon Conwell Theological Seminary in South Hamilton Massachusetts and his Juris Doctor from the University of Illinois College of Law. Dennis also spent a year in Stirling, Scotland, Great Britain as an exchange student majoring in English Literature and Political Science.

After practicing law in Illinois as in-house counsel at Rockford Health System for several years, Dennis was called to be the Director of Compassion Ministry at Forest Hill Church, in Charlotte NC where he developed the Outreach efforts for Urban Ministry connecting a large 3000+ member suburban church to the inner city. He was the first African American on the pastoral staff and led the church in developing partnerships with 'inner city' ministries and churches throughout the city. It was in this role that Dennis met Drew and Cathy Smith.



Dennis is excited to share his heart and passion for equipping the Church to Know Christ, Grow in Christ and Go for Christ. He has a unique combination of great love for people, networking and administrative acumen. Dennis has ministered overseas in Uganda, Rwanda, S. Sudan, Pakistan, Haiti, El Salvador, Mexico, Europe and North Africa. Dennis centers his ministry and life on a 'theology of reconciliation' and a 'theology of Kingdom' and most of all a love for Jesus Christ. His personal mission statement is to "know Christ and make Him known."

Dennis is married to his lovely wife, Sharon Louise and they have four children: Joshua David (16), Caleb Mandela (15), Lydia Louise (13), and Noah Adam (12). All 4 Hall children are all gifted soccer players and the family spends most evenings and Saturdays on the soccer field. In addition to soccer the family also enjoys camping, hiking, sci-fi movies and board games.

For such a time as this the Halls are called to Cincinnati and look forward to joining the CHPC family to accomplish the work of the Kingdom for the Honor and Glory of God in Christ Jesus.

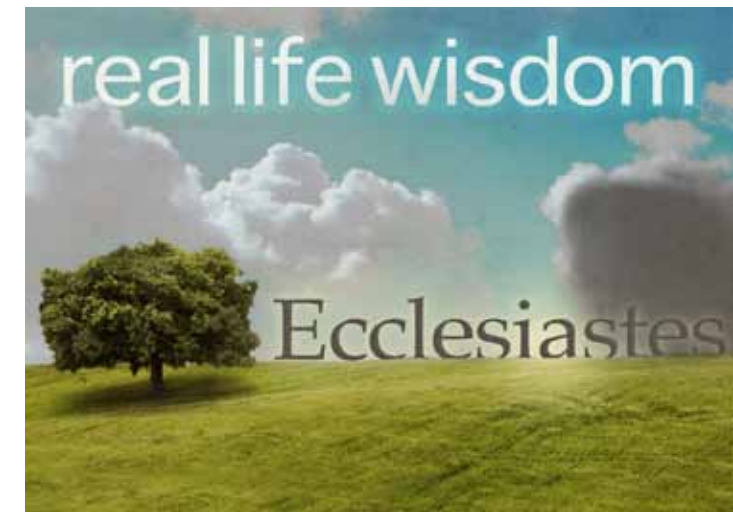
