It’s almost that time of year!!!! Woo Hoo, they’ll be going back! To many children this is horrendous, horrible news. But to children in urban schools, this means 2 meals a day and structure. Feast of Love is gearing up for our annual “Tools for Schools” program. Each year we fax an order form to each of the schools, asking for the quantity of supplies needed in each of the categories. Last year, with your help we served 27 schools with a total of 10976 students! We gave away 62,690 pencils, 14,458 spiral notebooks, 18,354 folders, 4,546 scissors, 5,909 boxes of crayons, 1,179 boxes of colored markers, 3,345 pens, 4,608 rulers and 7,511 glue sticks. Amazing! All the glory goes to God!

This year our hope is to add more schools to the program, but we need your help.

Spread the word to your neighbors, friends and family about “Tools for Schools”.

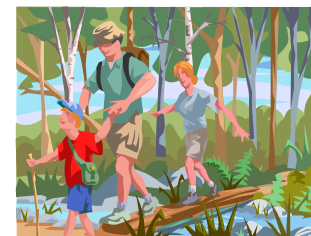
