Fireside Chat with Missionary Speaker Bethany Custer Sunday, July 26 Only at 10:10am

Bethany Custer has spent the last year discipling students at Miami University through the ministry of Cru. She has met regularly, one on one with many young women as well organized campus activities designed to connect with new comers. This fall she begins a new phase of ministry as a missionary to the Balkan country of Montenegro where only 3% of the population identifies themselves as Christian in spite of centuries of connection with the Eastern Orthodox Church. Cru has had a team in Montenegro for several years now and has established a beachhead with students there. Bethany will be part of that team. Bethany Custer is no stranger to CHPC, having grown through our youth program and assisted there as well as with the youth program at Madeira Silverwood.

Adult Spiritual Formation Update by William Custer

What does it mean to be "Spiritually Formed"? It is both a present reality and a continuing action. St. Paul says we are already saints but at the same time have not yet arrived. We are "already" but "not yet". Do you have some forming that is not yet complete? You may need help from the body of Christ, the church.

How can you get help? You could join us in one of four Spiritual Formation classes described below that are already in session. You could join Drew in a three week Exploration Class that begins Aug. 2. You could come hear Bethany Custer describe God's work at Miami University and her new mission in the Balkan country of Montenegro. Half of summer is yet before us and there is never a better time.

BT15: Only Two Religions

If you survey the religious landscape of modern culture, you encounter an astonishing diverse range of views. But beneath the surface, these seemingly disparate spiritualities share a common worldview, one that is radically opposed to the Christian faith. Join Dr. Peter Jones, professor of practical theology at Westminster Seminary California, as he explains, and then applies the truths from Romans 1 to the worldviews and religious convictions that drive modern culture. SP24: Cat and Dog Theology

Most of what you know about the Bible is not incorrect...it is incomplete! This DVD-driven class is full of humor and Scripture that will drastically change your life's priorities. Warning: This material has a proven track record of altering long-term goals and dreams. It's for those serious about obeying what God reveals to them. Visit Montenegro July 26 at 10:10 in Fellowship Hall with Bethany Custer

"People don't really talk about God or religion here" was what people said to Bethany when she asked about their spiritual background during a visit to Montenegro in the Spring. Thankfully, the team of Miami graduates



living there have made significant relationships with students and really paved the way for spiritual conversations to be more commonplace.



Bethany [on the left in the photo above] said, "I attended CHPC as long as I can remember" and her Mission Vision grew through the church's mission trips to Budapest, Hungary and Stanford Le Hope, England. As a student and worker at Miami University, she was involved with Cru (formerly Campus Crusade for Christ) building relationships with and discipling women who want to grow in their faith.

Next year she joins a team in Montenegro — nestled south of Bosnia-Herzegovina and north of Albania and Kosovo in the 'Balkans' — to work with college students there. Traditionally an Eastern Orthodox Church culture with some Muslim communities, less than 0.1% have a personal relationship with God. Many students are indifferent to God especially those whose families and country has suffered the ravages of war.

July 17- 24, Bethany and two other Cru staff will participate in **Equipping Ministries International's International School of Service (ISOS)** in Cincinnati to enrich their relationship-building skills: *Quick to Listen Leaders*, *Listening for Heaven's Sake*, *Speaking the Truth in Love*, *Renewing the Mind*, *Confronting Conflict*, *OUTFLOW Evangelism* and an evening of healing prayer. Many of the courses were developed at CHPC and have been refined over the years. Each course is normally taught in 1 1/2 days. During ISOS, Christian Leaders from all over the world learn one per day. Some describe it like drinking from a fire hose!

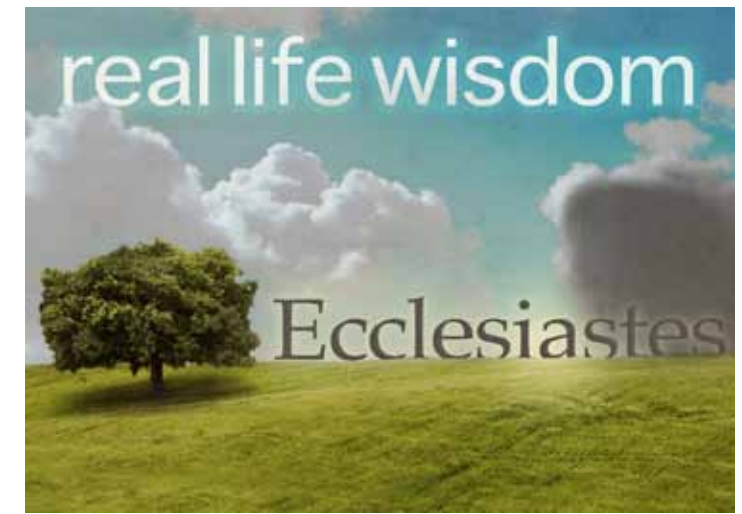
