

Ministry Partner Opportunities with Whiz Kids – Join our Team!

Are you willing to be a voice of Jesus speaking into the life of a child here in College Hill? Whiz Kids is a tutoring program in which we (CHPC) partner with City Gospel Mission (who provides training, materials, and guidance) to offer a faith-based tutoring program at our neighborhood elementary school, Pleasant Hill Academy. We need new tutors for this school year and hope to grow the program by spreading the effort with some new roles. See the various roles described below and let us know if you are willing to join or call us if you have any questions. This is a great opportunity to serve and join our team in helping impact Pleasant Hill with the good news of Jesus!

Tutors Can you commit to an hour each week from 5pm-6pm to tutor a 1st through 3rd grader? We always have a waiting list of students we would love to be a part of our program, so we always have need of tutors.

Tutor substitutes Would you be willing to be on a sub list so we could call you if we have a sick or absentee tutor? Let us know and we will add you to our list.

Student Folder Preparation Time Commitment: 1-2 hours per week. This role involves putting a book and worksheets into student folders each week. You select from a library of books appropriate for each student and identifies level. Worksheets need to be printed out so being able to download and print materials from the Whiz Kids website is needed. The curriculum website is straightforward, but training is available. This is a great opportunity to pray for each student as you fill their folder and see their progress.

Party Planner Do you miss helping out with your kids' school parties? This would be a great role for you. We have two parties a year, one at Christmas and one at the end of the year in April. The parties last about an hour and usually include a few games and snacks. This can also be a team effort.

Prayer Warrior For those of you who know the power of prayer and the importance of it for every endeavor, we would love to have you praying for our tutors and students each week. This would include prayer for interactions between tutors and their Whiz Kid, between tutors and parents of their Whiz Kid, prayer for the tutors, spiritual awareness of everyone.

Devotionals We begin each tutoring session with a devotional group time. This is a 5-10 minute devotional time for the 9-13 students, where we share a bible story or object lesson that presents a Christian character attribute or truth of God. We would love to have adults available for as many times as you would like.

Mentor Coach Research shows mentoring is the most important aspect of tutoring. Once a tutor has been with a child for several months, he or she may move into the role of a mentor. This allows the tutor to meet with the child outside of school hours and setting. City Gospel Mission requires us to have a Mentor Coach to be able to offer our tutors these mentoring opportunities. This would require attending the training from City Gospel to learn about Mentor coaching and then a periodic connection with the adult mentors to encourage, offer resources and pray with them.

Family Fun Committee This is still in the brainstorming and planning stage but we would like to have occasional times where we can have a fun activity after the tutoring time to engage the parents. We would love to have a few adults brainstorm, plan and help put these activity times together.

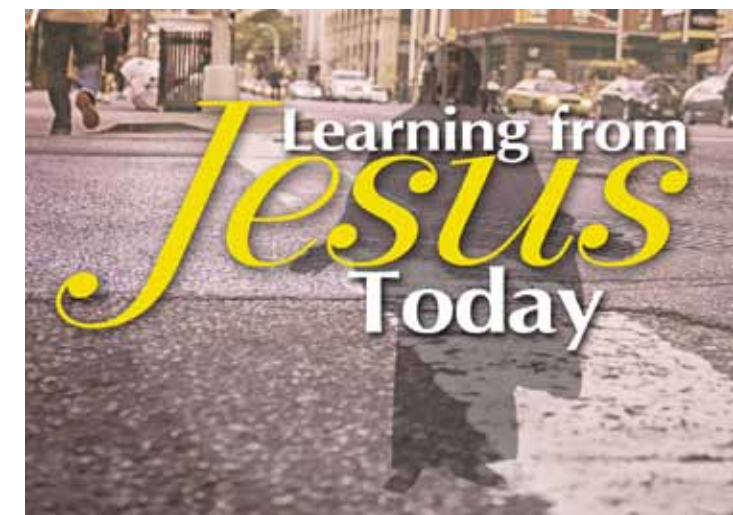
