This year *Tools for Schools* is focusing on **Crayons and Cash for buying in bulk**. For 15 years, God has used *Tools for School* as practical means of expressing Christ's love and care for children and to build up city school and teachers. **Ask others to join you in helping.**

Envisioned by Feast of Love Ministries Co-Founder Karen Lane, *Tools for School* provides 'Tools for Success' to Cincinnati Public Schools where many families living below the 'poverty line.' Supplies are distributed through 32 Inner city schools serving over 13,000 kids. Pictured is a portion of the 16,000 notebooks, and other *Tools* distributed last year. 60+ volunteers assembled a total of 112,000 items for the schools to pick up.

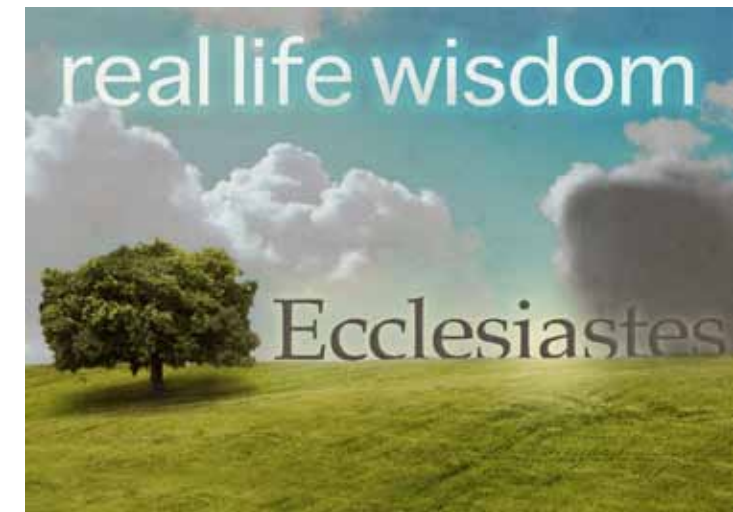
