What's New in Children's Ministry?

We have a new vision. The goal is to create a fun and exciting ministry that will help to nurture the faith and spirituality of all young people at CHPC. BLAST

We have a new name: BLAST. BLAST stands for Bible Learning And Sharing Truth and will be for children in 1st through 6th grade. BLAST will be located in the BLAST Zone (Great Hall) and will include new curriculum, live worship, live skits, games and large group and small group teaching.

252 Basics curriculum is organized around key Bible stories that help your kids discover Jesus and reflect His character to the world around them. 252 Basics invites your child into the Story of God, to show them the character of God, all while helping them internalize the 3 Basic Truths:

- I need to make the wise choice.
- I can trust God no matter what.
- I should treat others the way I want to be treated.

It also throws in some unforgettable illustrations, activities, and graphics to capture their attention and keep it relevant.

Mini BLAST

Mini BLAST reaches children from birth through Kindergarten and will be located in the 3C's hallway utilizing the nursery and classrooms. Mini BLAST is also using a new curriculum that is full of fun activities, Bible stories, worship and crafts. First Look curriculum's goal is to give preschool children a first impression of their loving heavenly Father. The curriculum keeps it simple and fun, repeating one basic truth about God all month long.



First Look also helps children understand worship and introduces them to small group time.

The activities tickle all the senses making mastering the concepts a BLAST. Crazy fun activities, crafts, large group Bible story and worship time, and small group Bible time, are all part of the plan to help your child believe three key things:

- God made me.
- God loves me.
- Jesus wants to be my friend forever.
