We are open to other kids joining, inside the church and outside in the community, as we get ready for the holiday season. We welcome boys and girls ages 5 to 15, after that age they are welcome to join Anointed Vessels, a more advanced team. Everyone is expected to come and be ready to dance. We do have an expectation that parents know their children are at practice and in a safe environment, and will be asked to leave if they are disruptive.

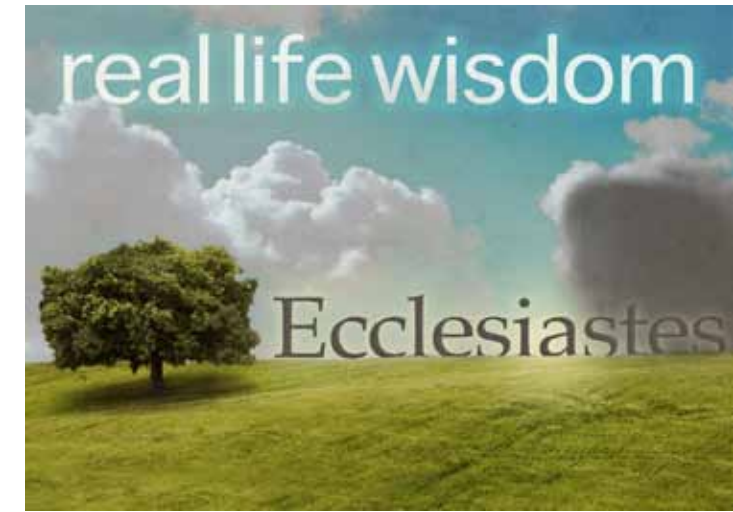

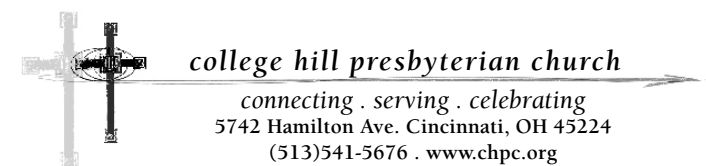
