Sleeping Sound is a new program in which Feast of Love is partnering with The Cincinnati Police Department. This program is specifically designed for children living in poverty to obtain their own bed. There are many children, in the Cincinnati area, sleeping on the floor.

We believe these children will perform and have better behavior in school with a good night's sleep. This program will work in conjunction with the Principals of Cincinnati area schools where students have family incomes below the poverty level.

The Principals and school staff will identify a child/children in need of a bed and The Cincinnati Police Department will deliver the bed/beds.

The total cost for a hotel quality mattress and box spring with a bed bug encasement and sheets is \$275.00 per bed.
