

Cincy Walks For Kids 2014

Dear Friends and Family,

Again this year, I will be joining thousands of patients, families and supporters of Cincinnati Children's at Cincinnati Walks for Kids on Saturday, Sept. 27, 2014, at the Cincinnati Zoo & Botanical Garden. I have re-formed Team "GORDO-RAPTORS" for this year's walk. Please consider sponsoring me this year! Thank you very much to everyone who sponsored me last year. Your kind support was appreciated.

My goal is to raise funds to help Cincinnati Children's bring hope and healing to children and their families. I have told them that all my money should go to Epilepsy Care & Treatments as well as Epilepsy Surgery!

Most of you probably know that I had neurosurgery at Cincinnati Children's Hospital this past February. Unfortunately, they were not able to go forward with the second part of the surgery and were therefore unable to help me. Even though things didn't turn out as we had hoped, my family and I have nothing but praise for the care we received at Cincinnati Children's. With the help of the Doctors in Cincinnati, I was seen at the Cleveland Clinic in July. There I was able to have a cutting edge diagnostic surgery (SEEG). As a result, Cleveland will be able to perform the major brain re-sectioning surgery for me in November. They have given me a 60-70% chance of being helped, although they anticipate that I may have life-long deficits as a result of the procedure.



I know that the Epilepsy team in Cincinnati wants to be able to help children here with the same diagnostic procedure (SEEG) that I had. (Cleveland has been the only hospital in North America doing this). Now, more than ever, each of us can make a difference in the life of a sick child.

My mom has always told me that GOD picked me to be special, and that I have Epilepsy for a reason. I said I wish GOD had picked a better way to make me special. She tells me that maybe because of me something will happen, like a chain of events will start and I will help all people who have Epilepsy, or that there will be more compassion for children who have become handicapped through no fault of their own.

With your help, perhaps we can change the outcome for kids – one step, or one less seizure, at a time.
