TEAM GORDO-RAPTORS

The message below is about Gordon Huston and his "Cincinnati Walks for Kids" team, the Gordo-Raptors.

Gordon has Intractable Epilepsy. His first seizure started about a week before he entered pre-school eleven years ago. Gordon has had three neurosurgeries over the past 1 1/2 years (both at Cincinnati and the Cleveland Clinic). The most recent was November 13th, 2014. The left temporal lobe of his brain was removed at that time.

Supporting Patients and Teams like Gordon's, are a very positive way for folks to help Children's Hospital. Events like this do double duty. They raise funds and self-esteem. Please, please encourage folks to help us help Children's Hospital. I have been letting folks understand that a few days in an Epilepsy Monitoring unit can cost a family more than \$50,000!!! The better the equipment, etc. the more productive and helpful those days become for the patient and families.

Donations have been lower this year and it is hard for Gordon to understand that it is not seen as a personal reflection on him. The walk was held yesterday, but there is still time to make a donation. Thank you again to everyone who has donated to the Walk so far!!
