What's happening with Feast of Love?

Well... Tools for Schools was a great success. Sam Stare writes: "The 2014 Tools For Schools Distribution Day was Friday, Aug 22. Through the generosity of many donors in multiple churches, grants and wise shopping, there were a lot of school supplies to distribute. That day volunteers sent out 112,343 much needed 'tools' to schools as close as College Hill Fundamental, Pleasant Hill, Winton Hills and Bond Hill. Others went to more remote public, Catholic and charter schools where the income of the family of many students was below the poverty level.

Tools for Schools supplies will be the source of many blessings throughout the school year. Thanks to grants and private donations, these 'tools' were distributed: 63,078 pencils, 3187 pens, 7521 glue sticks, 4812 boxes of crayons, 15,689 spiral notebooks and 18,056 two-pocket portfolios.

Bonus for 3c's Nurserty School & Kindergarten - The 2014 Tools For Schools (TFS) bulk buying team begins searching for bargains about mid-June. Since 70 page spiral notebooks are a prime paper source for TFS, we bought over 15,000 at 17¢ each as soon as WalMart put them on sale. We also bought Crayola crayons (24 count box) for 50¢ each. This was done in 9 major purchases totaling \$2,872.88 during WalMart's Teachers Appreciation Week July 25-31. While Feast of Love/ Tools For Schools didn't qualify for a 10% WalMart rebate, we filed for it on behalf of 3C's Nursery School. The school received gift cards for 10% of the TFS purchases or \$287 — "such a deal!"

Camp S'more is scheduled for October 8th & 9th. You can make a difference in a child's life by adopting a child for \$50.00. This cost covers renting the camp facility and the busses. You can also help by donating supplies. See the table in the atrium for details. All supplies need to be brought to the church by October 5th. Let me know if you are interested in volunteering either or both days!

Find a Need and Fill It has been very busy donating beds and furniture. In the past two months we have donated 50 beds, 15 couches, 10 dining room tables and chairs and 5 dressers. One woman who was coming out of a battered women's shelter came to the warehouse with several members from her church. As I watched this woman walk through the warehouse, she chose items that built a home for her and her young daughter. I was overwhelmed and blessed to see how excited she was to have furniture and beds. God is Amazing!

A generous donation was made by Gary Pies as an honorarium for his wife Marcia. Gary and Marcia are former members of CHPC and Gary volunteered for Feast of Love for many years.
