Staff Support Team... Working to provide rest and renewal

The Staff Support Team works hard to encourage and help the staff at CHPC so that they can excel at the work God has prepared for them. We also develop policies and plans to maximize staff development. Praying without ceasing for God's will to be done and God's name to be glorified in our work.

We have been working on a Sabbath plan for our staff. We know that God calls us to rest from our labors. Social research demonstrates the benefits of rest for all workers. In addition, the work of ministry never ends and can lead to burn-out. So, we have encouraged our staff to use the full complement of their vacations. In addition, we are adding a seven year Sabbath schedule for all full-time salaried employees. After seven years of employment, Pastors and Ministry Directors (currently we have 3 Directors - Youth & Service; Care, Counseling & Connecting, and Children & their Families) will receive a paid 6 week sabbatical. All other full-time salaried staff will receive an additional two weeks of vacation in their 7th year.

Jeanne Schneider has been employed at CHPC for 8 years as the Director of Care, Counseling & Connecting. She will be the first to enjoy this Sabbath rest starting on Oct. 18 and returning on Nov. 30. Jeanne has developed excellent teams of CHPC'ers to carry out the ministry while she is out of the office. Counseling interns will continue caring for the acute needs that arise. In addition, Pastors Drew and Dennis will be available for any other concerns. Let us be in prayer for Jeanne that God blesses her with rest and renewal of mind, body and soul during this time.

The Staff Support Team will arrange and organize the sabbaticals so that they don't overlap. We are working now with Pastor Drew to schedule his sabbatical for 2017 when he plans to finish his doctoral studies and dissertation.

The Staff Support Team gladly announces that Brian Donaldson has returned from his two month leave of absence having made great strides toward health. Brian will be working with the music ministry for the next three months on a reduced level as a "Worship Coach" to the Lead Worshippers and musicians.
