Church: With One Another in Christ Sermon Series – October 19 - November 23

How are we connecting with one another in Christ? Jesus talks about how the people of the church must love one another. The Apostle Paul talks about how we must bear one another's burdens, encourage one another, and forgive one another. For us to be the church then we must be connecting with one another in significant ways. However, from the REVEAL survey we took last spring and from other feedback from you, we don't do this very well. Regular visitors to CHPC say, "We find the church so welcoming and kind but how do we connect with one another? I feel like I'm on the outside." That's not good. Throughout the New Testament, the church is commanded to connect with one another. This is not an option. So, this fall, starting Oct. 19, we will be exploring what it means to connect with one another in Christ. Why is this essential? Is it possible? What gets in the way? How do we connect with one another as Jesus envisioned for His church.

Remember our Connect 3 Challenge? Connect with God; Connect with someone outside the Church; and Connect with someone inside CHPC. We just spent 6 weeks talking about and practicing connecting with God. These upcoming 6 weeks we will be discussing and practicing connecting with one another in the church. We will use the foundation hour to connect with one another in small discussion groups. This should be a great time to meet new people and grow in relationships with some folks you already know. A perfect place to practice what Jesus tells us is essential for a flourishing church – connect with one another. These groups combined with the worship gatherings and sermon series will provide growing environments for us to live into our Church without Walls prayer, "Connect us in Jesus no matter our differences."

As we progress in this series, you will be hearing about new forms and familiar ways that we can continue to "love, support, encourage, and forgive one another in Christ" beyond this six weeks series. Be listening for different options like support groups, missional communities, and life groups. More will be shared on those as we progress. For now, everyone needs to make an effort to participate in a group in order to enjoy one another and thrive as a church who 'one anothers' in Christ. Signup sheets will be in the atrium so that all can participate in this most crucial Church-wide Journey.

Remember from October 19 – November 23, set aside the Foundation hour to enjoy one another in Christ in our small groups.
