

#### 8 Questions about the CHPC Endowment, the CHPC Endowment Committee and the CHPC Trustee Administrators.

- 1. What is the CHPC Endowment?** In 1975, the College Hill Presbyterian Church Endowment was formed. It is separate fund of CHPC held in a trust wherein the principal money is invested, and income generated by the investment of the fund is to then be given away in the form of grants.
- 2. Who manages the CHPC Endowment?** It is overseen by the CHPC Trustee Administrators who are responsible for ensuring that the Fund is properly invested. The fund monies are invested and managed by an independent, investment company who provides a yearly report to the Trustee Administrators. The Trustee Administrators are elected by the congregation, one new member per year, to serve a 5-year term. The current members are: Ann Klusmeier, Bart Sauer, Bill Wooten, and John Wendt. The Trustee Administrators determine how much money is to be distributed by the Endowment fund each year.
- 3. How much money was able to be given this year from the Endowment?** In 2016 a total of \$38,000 was granted, distributed among 9 recipients.
- 4. Who determines who receives the grants?** A separate Endowment Team reviews applications for grants and makes recommendations to the CHPC Session for approval. For 2016/17, the members of the Endowment Committee are: Mark Fay, Chris Evans, Jacky Kalubi, Bart Sauer, Claire Snyder, and Chappie Chapman. If you are interested in being a part of this committee, you may contact Pastor Chappie, or any of the other committee members.
- 5. What are the grants for?** Each year the CHPC Endowment committee has the privilege of issuing grants to be used for missions or outreach with the following guidelines:
  - To aid evangelism and compassion for groups or people "beyond the walls" of CHPC.
  - The monies are to be used for one-time expenditures, instead supporting an organization's annual budgeted expenditures.
  - An outcome report documenting the use of grant must be made to the CHPC Endowment committee within one month after the funds are used and no later than nine (9) months following receipt of the grant.
- 6. What were some of the grants given this year?**
  - Bible Telling which translates bible stories into Mandarin audio recordings.
  - Manoach Missions and Training Center – monies provided to fund a generator for electricity to their meeting hall.
  - Scholarships for under-resourced youth to hear the Gospel at Young Life Camp.
  - Scholarships for under-resourced youth to attend Swim Ministry.
  - The Callisons work overseas - to provide food and hygiene kits for refugees.
  - Baptist Collegiate Ministry - 850.00 toward welcome bags for International students which included Jesus DVD and other faith based materials.
- 7. How could I give to the Endowment fund?** While it is possible to make contributions to the Endowment fund at any time, most of the money contributed in the past has come as part of a person's will/estate upon their death, or by friends or family contributing to the CHCP Endowment in memorial to that person. If you have any more questions about the Endowment Fund, or would like to know more about how to contribute, please feel free to ask any of the Trustee Administrators or contact Heather Lethander in the CHPC finance office. The Endowment fund is intended to be a forward-looking option for gifts to the church, designed to grow over time so that its resources will continue to carry out the church's mission for years to come.
- 8. Are applications available for 2017 distributions?** Yes. Applications are now available on the CHPC website or in atrium racks at the church. Applications are due back by October 31.




## Available Help
