Blessed to Be a Blessing The Endowment Fund Outreach Grants

Be a part of sharing the Blessings AGAIN

Every year for the last 37 years, CHPC has distributed money from the Endowment Fund to Christian Ministries here in College Hill, in Cincinnati, across the US, and around the world. The process to make next year's annual distribution starts **NOW** with your help.

The Endowment Fund Committee, chaired by Rev. "Chappie" Chapman, wants to get this year's Outreach Project Grant Request form into the hands of Ministries so that they may apply for a 2014 Financial Grant.

This is an opportunity for **YOU** to help CHPC connect and serve. Maybe you know about a current financial need of a local, national or international Ministry that should be considered by the Endowment Fund Committee. You can pick up forms in the information racks around church, at the front desk, online at chpc.org or contact "Chappie" at chappie45239@yahoo.com. Then give the application to that Ministry ASAP. Applications for 2014 grants are being accepted now through November 20, 2013.

Here are the needs that were met by the Endowment Fund during this last year:

Across the street...

Provided scholarships for local first time, un-churched and under-resourced teenagers to attend Young Life summer camp, funded the College Hill "Kids Impact" outreach program, helped get Operation Mustard Seed Project started at CCCH Youth Ministry, provided scholarships for Swimmers at CHPC Summer Swim Ministry, helped Brooklyn Jubilee temporarily expand their legal services to poor in neighborhoods severely impacted by Hurricane Sandy, and continued to support CHPC Worship and Arts as required by Endowment Fund Gifts.

Around the world...

Funded a new deeper well at a Roma Development Center in Ukraine, covered publication and distribution costs for 500 copies of the Book of Genesis in the Indonesian Mpur language, helped Syrian refugee relief in northern Iraq, purchased special equipment to expand disabled athlete program in Turkey, funded development of curriculum and teaching materials for Honduran Sign Language courses, purchased laptop computers to improve teaching of EMI courses in India, helped with travel expenses for EMI Staff to train Christian leaders in Myanmar, provided funds to help train Core Leaders in 10 UCU (Unidad Cristiana Universitaria) charters in Colombia, and funded another solar power installation at an "off-grid" Honduran school.



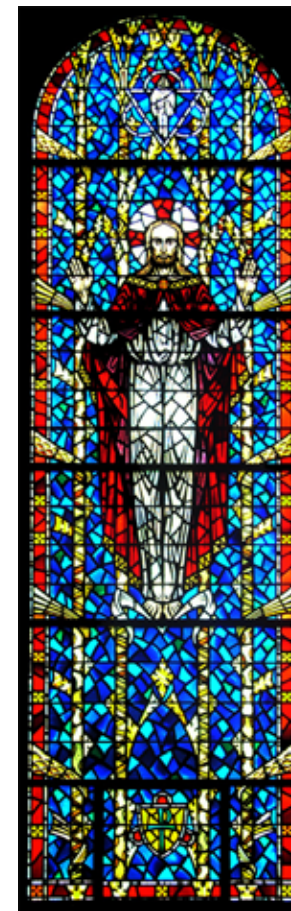
