Helping parents to shape vocabulary rich environments and prepare their children to read. Empowering parents to be advocates for their children in the educational system. Forming community through mutually beneficial relationships that bond families together in partnership with their peers.

We believe it is possible because we already see a similar call lived out at Three Cs Nursery School.

We've started by trying to get name recognition in College Hill. We've been attending community events like the Block Party, the Pumpkin Patch and Pleasant Hill's first Literacy Night. At these events we are connecting with parents with young children by giving away free children's books. The books include a bookmark printed with our name, logo, email address and mission. Many interested parents have demonstrated an enthusiasm for being involved in a community of encouragement and support.

Next, we will be offering a four-week workshop in March of 2015. Ms. Arnice will be our main contributor. She will be teaching parents how to read to their kids and about developmental play among other topics. We will be offering door prizes and other incentives for parents who attend. We will also be inviting the families to FX Nights and coordinating other opportunities for them to continue meeting.

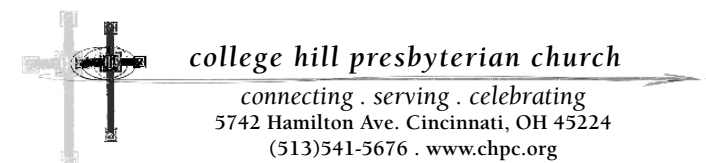
