It is time to form our summer ministries team. This year we are offering opportunities for young adults who have been out of high school for at least one year and who are committed Christians to:

- intern for 10 ½ weeks. Availability Sunday mornings through Labor Day preferred.
- Know Christ better; Grow in relationship with God, the family of God and the community; and to Go for Christ daily.
- Grow in leadership and explore the vocation of ministry:
 - Planning and leading youth ministry for Tweens which includes Bible Studies, club activities and contact work.
 - Being a camp counselor.
 - Planning, publicizing, and carrying out family life events that appeal to the generations and provide fun, fellowship and spiritual nurture.
 - Utilizing curriculum, planning, leadership and relationship skills to teach Sunday School.
 - Planning, publicizing and conducting activities for children
 - Help and provide leadership for other programming for children and families.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Christian Walk – A personal commitment to Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord; a love of, foundational knowledge, and continued growth in scripture, a strong desire to serve within a local church.
- Integrity – wholly surrendered and committed to Christ in both vocational and personal areas of life
- Demonstrated Leader – demonstrated ability to articulate a vision, recruit a team, develop a strategy for the team, and implement an effective team for ministry.
- Team Player – committed to lead and participate in teams as part of the larger body of Christ at CHPC. Has demonstrated the ability to work effectively with other ministry areas and all individuals.
- Strong Interpersonal Skills – demonstrated one on one discipleship and small group leadership skills. Able to work effectively with pastors, church leaders and staff.
- Administration – able to coordinate people, budgets, materials, information and programs effectively in a multiple staff, elder led congregation.
- Is aware of current systems and computing technology and able to use and direct its use to support children's programs.
