



## Introduces the Neighborhood HUB:

### A Safe, Supported Next-Step to Self-Sufficiency and Progress to the Path of Employment

Thanks to a grant from the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities, Easterseals Serving Greater Cincinnati has implemented a brand-new program to transition individuals from a sheltered work center facility to community-based experiences and employment. The Neighborhood Hub works collaboratively with local organizations and companies to engage in volunteer and communal events for people with disabilities. The HUB has been developed in line with the Employment First Initiative and Federal and State Policies and Actions Supporting Full Community Integration. Our third HUB host site is located in the College Hill Presbyterian Church. Each weekday the participants will meet in a classroom of the Church to develop a wide range of meaningful skills that facilitate social relationships, independence, self-esteem, health and wellness, recreation and employment. Since inclusion is the key component of this program, the community is used as a “classroom” as well. **The goal is for these**

## Pleasant Hill Snack Drive!

CHPC partners with our neighborhood elementary school, Pleasant Hill Academy, to show God’s love to staff and students in many different ways, from helping students succeed in school through Whiz Kids and Treehouse tutoring, to providing opportunities for students to learn new skills and be part of a team through the Pleasant Hill Soccer Program. Recently, Pleasant Hill has adjusted their lunch schedule to extend the morning hours when students tend to be more focused and productive. Because of the later lunch times, each of their 300 students now receives a late morning snack every day. A district grant provides fruits and vegetables for students two days a week, but that means the school is still looking for 900 additional snacks each week from now until the end of this school year!



Throughout the month of February, we will be collecting boxes/packages of individually wrapped snacks as well as grocery store gift cards to help provide Pleasant Hill students with the energy they need to work hard and learn well every morning. 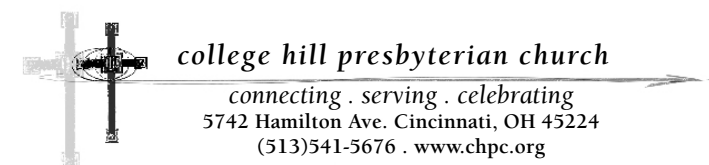
