## CHILDREN YOUTH & FAMILIES SUMMER INTERNS

There are three different tracks for the 2017 Summer Internship. Focus 3 interns will build relationships with kids in grades K-6 at Swim Ministry, at Resident Camp and Overnight Camp, in Children & Worship, and at weekly Megablast youth group meetings.

### IHN Volunteer Appreciation Night

Dave and Cyndi Butz are the Interfaith Hospitality Network (IHN) site coordinators for CHPC. Last month IHN held their annual Volunteer Appreciation Event. Dave and Cyndi were chosen as coordinators of the year. While they faithfully serve 3-4 times per year when CHPC hosts IHN, they were also integral in helping with the use of Grace Place as a new site.

Homelessness increases in the summer time. CAIN (Churches Acting In Northside) was granted last year the old Grace Place property in College Hill. They approached IHN about using it for hosting families. It was a huge success and has continued to host families. Grace Place allowed for additional groups to try out hosting and allowed churches that don't have the facilities to host by using Grace Place rather than their church buildings. Dave and Cyndi have supported the efforts at Grace Place in addition to hosting at CHPC.

IHN greatly depends on host and support churches to further their mission. It is estimated that the host churches, by providing meals and lodging, save IHN \$350,000 annually that allows them to use that money for support services. Dave and Cyndi were recognized this year for their outstanding and dedicated service to IHN. CHPC is one of 27 host congregations, so it is quite an honor for them to be recognized for this award. Please congratulate them the next time you see them, or better yet, ask how you can help.
