Mark your calendars, August 1-3. Yes....it's that time again for our 'all church' Outreach Event, **The National Night Out/College Hill Community Block Party**. This is an all CHPC 'hands on deck' Outreach opportunity for the whole family! We only do this once a year so don't miss your chance to give back to our community in Jesus' Name!

### WHAT is National Night Out?

For the past 14 years, we have participated in the "NATIONAL NIGHT OUT" by hosting the **College Hill Community Block Party**. "NNO" is a nation-wide event created to honor local law enforcement, fire-fighters and other public officials and civil servants. And equally important, this event makes possible for all members of our community to come together and celebrate what we have in common and how we all contribute to our neighborhood and to each other. We want CHPC to be known as a good citizen and a good neighbor in College Hill. This year's 2 day outdoor Event will be held **Tuesday August 1, and Wednesday 2nd from 6:00pm - 8:30pm in our parking lot.**

### UNITY WALK

We start the Festivities with a UNITY WALK. Our Unity Walk is such an important component for the Block Party; it sets the tone for the following days. It is a visible demonstration of our togetherness 'no matter our differences' and it's led by our faith leaders in the community demonstrating our trust and dependence on God. ATTENTION: All are invited. Signup is at 5:45pm by the stage. There's an opportunity to walk 1 or 2 miles. If you are more adventurous there's a bike tour and a running group as part of the Unity demonstration as well. If you are able, please come and walk with us. If you are unable to walk, still come to the opening

### NEW THIS YEAR!!! THE OPERA EXPRESS

We are excited to introduce a new showcase called **The Opera Express**. This classical showcase is presented by the Cincinnati Opera and is literally an Opera on Wheels. How? A semi-truck will be located on the CHPC parking lot equipped with a stage, seating for 25 people, air conditioned and 3 classically trained singers. You do not want to miss this. Times for these performances are **6:15, 7:00, 8:00 and 8:45pm**. This is on Tuesday night only!

### ENTERTAINMENT

Entertainment this year will be spectacular including groups like Retro Vibes, 2 Jazz groups, D-Fresh, Black Tie, Rapper MC Till and Jazz/gospel saxophone player extraordinaire Ed Thomas. We have our own Mindy Nagel with Ballet Reflect,

Pleasant Hill Academy Mime/Dancers, Jesus University, Healing Drums and the College Hill Community Choir. Again, this year our College Hill Recreation Center will host the Final Basketball Tournament. Each night will have the moving train for younger children and the Gaming Truck for the youth and older. Other activities include, 2 bouncy houses, face painting, corn hole, bingo, Story Telling, elephant walk and much more

### SYMPOSIUM

Our culminating night August 3 will be very exciting and different than in previous years. It will feature a Community Symposium on Child Poverty with the discussion facilitated by organizations such as the Child Poverty Collaborative, Amos and Close the Health Gap. We are proud to partner with our own elementary school, **Pleasant Hill Academy**. This will also begin at 6pm. Our goal is to bring all sectors of College Hill together to inform, discuss and strategize how to tackle the issues that accompany child poverty.

# regeneration

The parking lot work at CHPC is now completed and the next major project (Stained Glass) is scheduled to begin tomorrow, Monday, July 24. As you may know, we have 70 exterior stained glass windows at CHPC. Seven of our larger 19th Century windows are in dire need of major restoration and repair work and most of the rest require more limited service. Willet-Hauser Architectural Glass of Winona, Minnesota, our stained glass contractor, will be removing those seven windows and transporting them to the Willet-Hauser studio for disassembly, repair and restoration, and reassembly. That renewal process is expected to take several months. When it is completed, the Willet-Hauser people will return to reinstall the windows, to do the necessary in-place service on the rest of our exterior stained glass, and to install new protective coverings on all our exterior stained glass.



The seven windows scheduled to be removed tomorrow are: the three large windows in the west wall of the North Narthex (facing Hamilton Avenue), the three large windows in the north (rear) wall of the chapel area of the sanctuary, and the exterior stained glass window in the Prayer Room (which can be viewed from inside the prayer room, or from outside the south Atrium doors to the left above the air conditioner unit). Take a good look now, because they'll be gone for awhile. Meantime, please be in prayer – thanking the Lord for those with the skills to do this work, and that the work would bless both the Willet-Hauser personnel and our congregation (and would go well – particularly removal of the weak windows will be a delicate and dicey task).

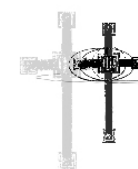
